IMPORTANT INFORMATION QR CODE CHECK IN ON DELIVERIES

It has been brought to our attention that there is a lack of clarity around deliveries to store. UCB have spoken to all of our trade partners to ensure they have a policy which covers their employees. However it is vital that as a site accepting a delivery, you make all staff understand they are responsible for enforcing all QR Code check ins as part of your own CovidSafe plan. A delivery driver is a contact so he must check in using the QR Code as per State Government guidelines, as your staff and customers do. There must be a QR Code sited at every entry point into a store (check you have one at your back door) and you are responsible for ensuring every delivery driver, courier and any other visitor to your store uses your QR code to check in.
